Dear Parent/Guardian,

We hope that you and your families are continuing to remain safe and well.

As the pastoral team for Lower School students we wanted to contact you let you know we are always here to support our students and families with remote learning and any home-schooling issues you may be experiencing. We know that this has been an unprecedented time for families and a return to school for students in Years 7 to 9 is looking unlikely until September, although we are always hopeful.
