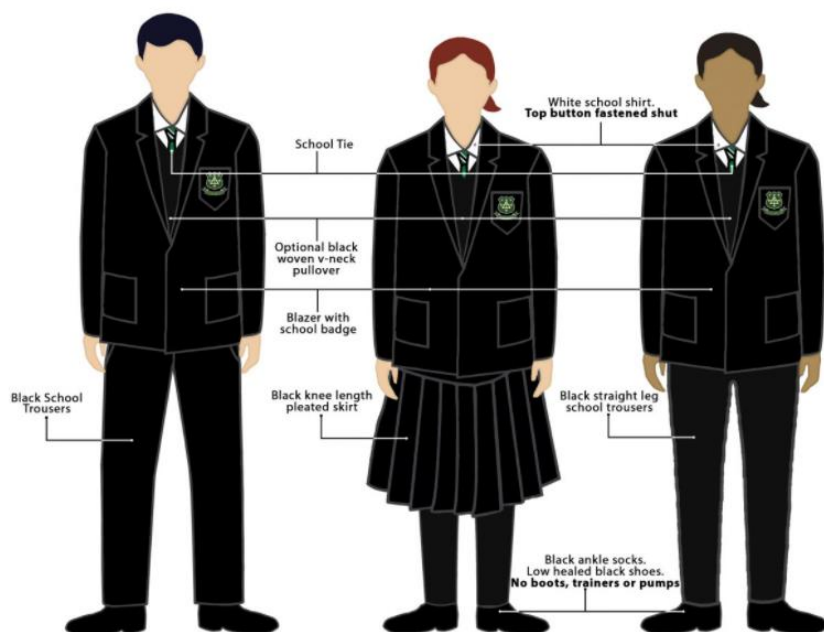


Uniform and Appearance Policy

The Trinity Catholic School Uniform and Appearance Policy



Uniform Year 7-11

Trinity black blazer (black buttons) with the school badge.

Plain black V-necked knitted jumper of orthodox style with no logo.

Plain white school shirt (not fitted).

School tie (available from the Beechdale Office).

Girl's Uniform

Plain black pleated skirt of knee length that is of a minimum 22 inches in length. The skirt should be made of a woven material. Pencil skirts are not allowed.

Plain black regular straight leg trousers. Trousers should not be tight fit or figure-hugging. Trousers must not have visible external pockets or metal rivets. No Jeans, chinos, corduroy, or leather trousers are allowed. Trousers should be replaced if they have rips or cuts in them.

Plain black ankle socks (or winter tights) for every day of the week.

Black low-heeled sensible shoes. Any stiletto style heels damage floors and may not be worn. Boots must not be worn in school

Trainers or trainer-like shoes must not be worn in school or to and from school.

Boy's Uniform

Plain black school regular fit standard trousers. Trousers should not be tight fit or figure-hugging. Trousers must not have visible external pockets or metal rivets. No Jeans, chinos, corduroy, or leather trousers are allowed. Trousers should be replaced if they have rips or cuts in them. A list of approved trousers and suppliers is available on the school website.

Plain black ankle socks for every day of the week.

Plain black shoes. Boots must not be worn in school. Trainers or trainer-like shoes must not be worn in school or to and from school

Outdoor coats must be of a plain dark navy blue or black. Multi-coloured or expensive fashion coats are not allowed. Denim, leather and leather-look coats are not acceptable. Coats with designer/advertising logos are not allowed. No fur on or inside of hoods.

No hats are to be worn apart from an optional plain black pull-on hat with the school's logo.

Girls' Hair Year 7-11

Pupils' hair must be in an understated style. Any hair clips or hair bands must be subtle and black or navy blue in colour.

Some specific styles that are not permitted:

- Styles where large bunches, buns or pony-tails on top of the head obscure the views of pupils sitting behind in class.
- Bows, flowers, clips, jewellery or other adornments in the hair.
- Hair that is teased, backcombed or be covered in excessive styling product (wax, gel, oil, etc.).
- Unnatural colours or hair that is noticeably more than one colour.
- Styles that hide the face or eyes making it difficult to see.
- Patterns shaved into the pupil's hair or eyebrows.

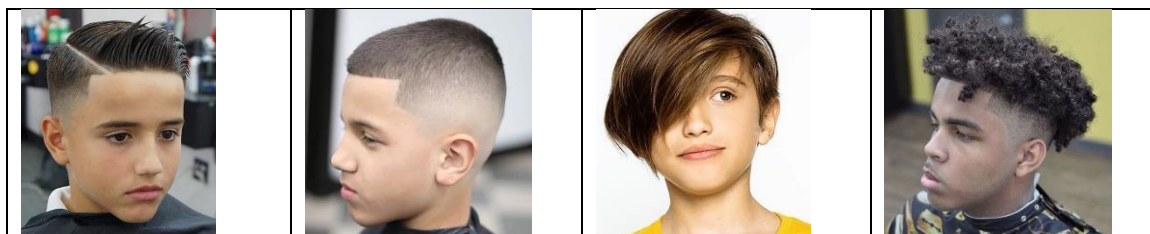
This list is not exhaustive and parents may get in touch to discuss a particular hairstyle after which the school's decision on what is/is not acceptable is final.

Boys' Hair Year 7-11

Boys in Years 7-11 are to be clean-shaven. Pupils' hair must be in an understated style. Boys' hair must be no longer than collar length and kept short on top and off the eyebrows and collar. In addition, there should be no contrast between the top of the hair and the sides. Short sides must be faded gradually into the top of the haircut so there is no noticeable 'step' or layering. No beads or hair accessories are permitted. Some specific styles that are not permitted:

- Hair which is cut below a Number 2 on the sides.
- Hair that is teased, backcombed or be covered in excessive styling product (wax, gel, oil, etc.).
- Patterns shaved into a pupil's hair or eyebrows, including an artificial parting.
- Flamboyant hairstyles, such as a 'Mohican' or styles that obscure the views of pupils sitting behind in class.
- Unnatural colours or hair that is noticeably more than one colour.
- Styles that hide the face or eyes making it difficult to see.
- Heavy floppy styles or large quiffs at the front.

This list is not exhaustive and parents may get in touch to discuss a particular hair style after which the school's decision on what is/is not acceptable is final.



Examples of some specific styles that are not permitted in School
