



# My First Day at Trinity in Pictures

## Finding your way around on the first morning



Students in **Year 7**, usually enter Trinity School through these two gates. The first can be found on **Beechdale Road**, to the far right of the front of School. The second entrance, is on **Kingsbury Drive**, between two Bungalows. On your first day, we would like you to use the gate on **Beechdale Road**. A member of the year 7 team will be there to meet you and keep the gate open for you



Please arrive at School between **8:30am** and no later than **8:50am**. Being late for School on your first day would be a terrible start to Secondary School.

On your second day of School in Year 7, you will be issued with a card. This will allow you entry through all the gates in and around the site. Please notice that the front gate will lock for your card at 8:50am and you will have to use an intercom to contact the office



From the entrance on Beechdale Road, you should be able to see the **Main School Building**. You will notice the White Building on the right. This is the Staff Room. The Main Building is where you will find the School Reception... a very important place!

You should also be able to see, what we call the **New Block**. This is the **Year 7** base. You will start every morning and every afternoon in this building. It's easy to spot, as it is a brand-new building. We are very lucky to have it for **Year 7**.



Until the bell rings at 8:50am, you are free to play on the yard. This is on the right-hand side as you enter. You could bring a very small football or a basketball and start a game, try and meet some new people or introduce yourself to one of the teachers on duty.



The main entrance for the new block is shown here. Once we get set-up, we may use different doors, but on your first morning you need to know this entrance.



Your Form Room will be in this New Block, and you will meet your Form Tutor twice a day.



Directly inside the New Block, on the right-hand side. Is Mr Holt's office. He is usually outside on the Playground, but very occasionally you might find him in here. There is a big window, but if you knock on the door – he'll be happy to speak with you.



More importantly, you can find both the boy's and girl's toilets in the New Block. They can be found if you go straight-on through the main entrance. These are open for you in the morning.



The entrance to the Sports Hall is located between the white Staff Room building and the Sixth Form Block (at the back of the image to the right). We use the Sports Hall entrance for the canteen. You can see on the wall, that we take turn with which Year goes first for lunch; for the first few weeks... Year 7 always go first!



In the morning, you might choose to eat a snack or buy some breakfast. You could bring a little bit of money on the first few days.

Once you are issued with your cards, the Canteen will not accept money. A meal currently costs £2.50 and is free to some children, but we have snacks and breakfast on sale for extra.



The School Reception is available should you need it. The staff are all really friendly and are always happy to help. If they feel in necessary, they can even call home for you.

Please remember your manners when speaking to staff working in the office.
